A **QUESTION MARK** CALLS FOR  
DEEPER INVESTIGATION OF A TOPIC.  
YOU SHOULD **NEVER ALLOW**  
YOURSELF TO BE PUT IN A  
**DEFENSIVE POSITION**

WHERE SOMEONE CAN  
QUESTION YOUR **CHARACTER,**  
**INTEGRITY, INTENTIONS,**  
**loyalties** OR  
**WORK ETHIC.**

**AN EXCLAMATION MARK**  
IS A **SYMBOL OF DISTINCTION,**  
SOMETHING OF IMPORTANCE WHICH  
**COMMANDS ATTENTION.**

LIVE IT WITH EXCELLENCE BY PLACING  
**AN EXCLAMATION MARK**
