A **QUESTION MARK** CALLS FOR
DEEPER INVESTIGATION OF A TOPIC.
YOU SHOULD **NEVER ALLOW**
YOURSELF TO BE PUT IN A
DEFENSIVE POSITION

WHERE SOMEONE CAN
QUESTION YOUR **CHARACTER,**
INTEGRITY, INTENTIONS,
loyalties OR
WORK ETHIC.

AN EXCLAMATION MARK
IS A **SYMBOL OF DISTINCTION,**
SOMETHING OF IMPORTANCE WHICH
COMMANDS ATTENTION.

YOUR LIFE IS YOUR MESSAGE TO THE WORLD.
LIVE IT WITH EXCELLENCE BY PLACING
AN EXCLAMATION MARK
AT THE END OF EVERYTHING YOU DO! ”
